WORK UNDER THE DECREE

- Certain "lettres d'entente" have been signed in November with "la partie négociante provinciale":
 - 1- "Lettre d'entente" #6 approving "perfectionnement" funds already spent (on which we already agreed) for 1983-84.
 - 2- "Lettres d'entente" #8 and 9, specifying the "comité consultatif sur la tâche"'s mandate. Claude Racine of Outaouais CEGEP have been nominated by "the bureau fédéral" to accomplish this task.

It is important to note that all these agreements have been made with the reservation that they are conditional upon a court judgement concerning the validity of laws 70 and 105.
- "Comité de résorbition" : The Government has finally agreed to convoque the "comité de résorbition" after beating around the bush since last september. The first meeting will be held on february the 7th.
- There will be meetings with Government and the CEGEP federation:

Following madates voted at the last "Bureau Fédéral", a meeting will be held on February the 6th to negotiate the following agreements:

 - 1- Assure Heritage Campus a "partie locale" statute such that it can negotiate directly with Outaouais Cegep;
 - 2- Assure a republishing of the decree for all teachers with the admendments integrated;
 - 3- Preparation of a special 'role for old grievances.

There will also be discussions on the non-respect by the Government of it's engagement concerning the opening of 200 jobs in adult education and the measures necessary to remedy this situation.

RECYCLING MED

The "comité paritaire de placement" which also has the mandate of awarding recycling to MED has met a few times in the past months.

An important question dealt with was how many recyclings it could award for 84-85 school year. The decree was ambibuous on this subject. The major question being: does the decree allow 40 recyclings for it's duration or 40 recyclings a year? Since the parties were in disagreement, the president, Serge Savard, concluded as follows:

"The majority of the committee agrees to allow recycling demands each year of it's mandate in this proportion: either 40 or 5% of the number of MED's listed for that year on the "bureau de placement" list.

The committee will retain the lowest number. As of it's 31st of january meeting, the committee had allowed 31 recyclings based upon approximately one hundred demands. Those chosen will be contacted before February the 15th.
